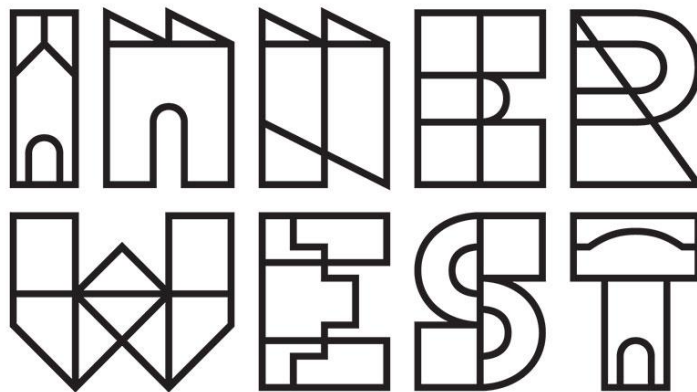

**Background**
