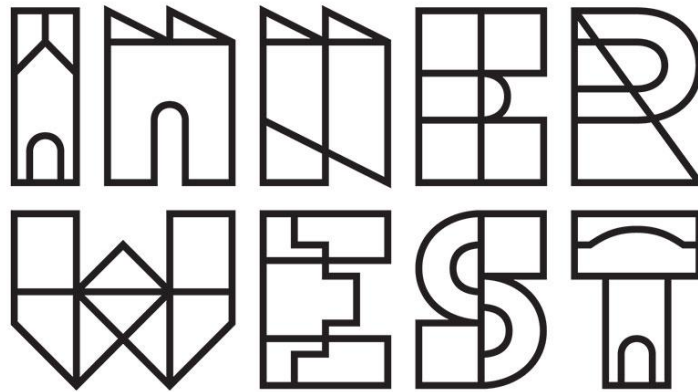

MOTION:

THAT Council:

- 1. Urgently writes to the Minister for Transport requesting an extension of the exhibition period to 20 October in order for council to be able to brief Councillors and conduct direct consultation with the local community;**
- 2. Receive a Councillor Briefing on the Sydney Park Junction proposal as soon as possible; and**
- 3. Consults directly with the local community on the proposal as outlined by Transport for NSW in the exhibited Environmental Factors.**

Background

The Sydney Park review of Environmental Factors is currently on exhibition. Exhibition runs for 28 days and closes on Monday 4 October. Council has not done any direct consultation on this proposal, relying entirely on the word of Transport for NSW that the community are happy with the project. Council’s “Have Your Say” does not go back to council but to the Transport for NSW website.

This proposal has its origins with WestConnex. It was developed to address concerns about potential clearways on King Street. Key issues of concern are: vehicle access in the St Peter’s triangle; pushing more traffic onto Campbell Street and Campbell Road; longer vehicle trips; the impacts on Tempe have not been considered and the impact on low volume residential roads.
