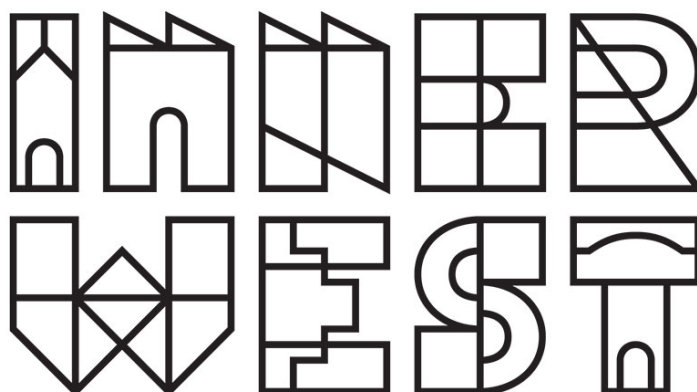

Please advise whether the DCP is relevant at all in State Significant Development Applications? Will the decision-maker take it into account at all?

Response Provided (by Director Planning):

The Housing SEPP calls up the Apartment Design Guide, and these documents sit above the DCP and the requirements within them apply first – where they are silent on a matter the DCP applies.

Just a reminder - to further support good design in SSDA proposals next month a council led planning proposal is coming before you that amends our LEP to ensure design excellence is considered regardless of who the consent authority / decision maker is - this planning proposal will seek to insert into our LEP a requirement that all medium density developments and above – not just those considered by Council – will be referred to a design excellence panel for review.
