Background

The Confidential Tender report for the Bay Run Path and Lighting Upgrade T14-21 requires consideration by Council at the extra-ordinary Council Meeting on the 2nd November 2021.

This contract is a part of the Greenway project, the tender for this project closed on the 5th October 2021 and has been in evaluation for the following three weeks. Due to the 2021 elections being rescheduled to early December, the caretaker period timeframe has changed which has directly impacted the timeline for Council to consider this report.

Due to the caretaker period restrictions commencing on 5 November 2021, this item requires an urgent decision by Council before the next scheduled ordinary meeting to ensure this project is not jeopardised or significantly delayed.

RECOMMENDATION

THAT Council adopt the recommendation contained in Confidential Attachment 1.

DISCUSSION

The Cooks to Cove Greenway Master Plan was adopted by Council in August 2018 and sets out \$27m of priority works to be delivered by 2023. The Cooks to Cove Greenway Master Plan identifies upgrades to the Bay Run as the northern gateway to the Greenway.

The Bay Run Path and Lighting Upgrade incorporates civil, landscape, lighting and electrical works along the bay run from UTS Haberfield Rowing Club to Lilyfield Road and connecting into Richard Murden Reserve.

The proposed upgrade also includes lighting and electrical works along the Bay Run through Leichhardt Park, from Maliyawul Street to Glover Street, and, pending plan of management approval, from King George Park to under the Iron Cove Bridge.

On the 27 August 2021, Inner West Council invited tenders through Vendor Panel for the Bay Run Path and Lighting Upgrade, Tender 14-21.

Tenders were evaluated in accordance with Council's Purchasing Policy and Procedures and the Local Government Act 1993 and General Regulations 2005.

A summary of the Tender Evaluation Committee's report is attached as **Confidential Attachment 1**.

Pending Council approval, and the successful engagement of a Contractor, works are anticipated to commence in March 2022 and run until November 2022. Local residents and businesses will be notified prior to commencement of construction.
